Our Memory Verse this week:

"Without faith it is impossible to please God." Hebrews 11:6

Today we discovered:

- Faith results from a relationship with the Father
- Faith comes from hearing and recognizing God's Word
- Faith pleases the Father
- Knowing, believing, and trusting God is faith's foundation

Parent's Points to Ponder:

In this lesson our children will discover that faith pleases the Father, because it results from having a relationship with Him. Having strong faith in God says that we know who our Father is and that He is good. Our faith declares that we believe His Word as being true, and we trust He is able and willing to do what He promised. It delights our Papa when He sees His children full of faith and have confidence in Him as they bring what is in Heaven to earth.

Ask Your Child:

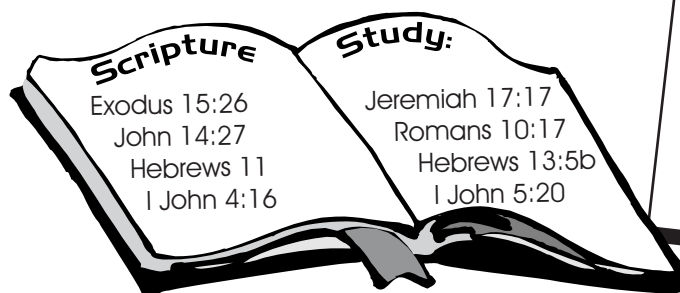
What was put into the Backpack? (it was a rope). How does faith come? (By hearing and recognizing God's Word) Why does faith please God? (Faith shows we know, believe and trust Him) What is the enemy of faith? (Unbelief)

Soaking Time:

In a quiet soaking atmosphere, have your child invite the Father's presence. Let them know they will receive faith as you read from God's Word. (Read John 14:27, Hebrews 13:5b, and Exodus 15:26). Invite them to be still and hear His voice, and receive what He wants to give to you. Have them thank Him for His Word, and for filling you with faith.

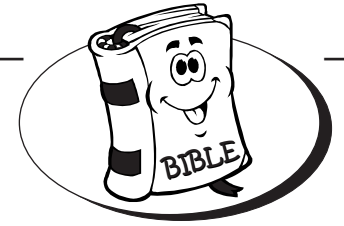
Home Activity:

Discuss with your child relevant issues, challenges and needs (personal, family, local and global). You may want to list them on a sheet of paper entitled "Opportunities". On a second sheet entitled "Faith Says", look up scriptures with your child that show God's promises for these situations. Post them side-by-side on bulletin board and encourage your child to pray faith-filled prayers and also pray the scriptures listed.

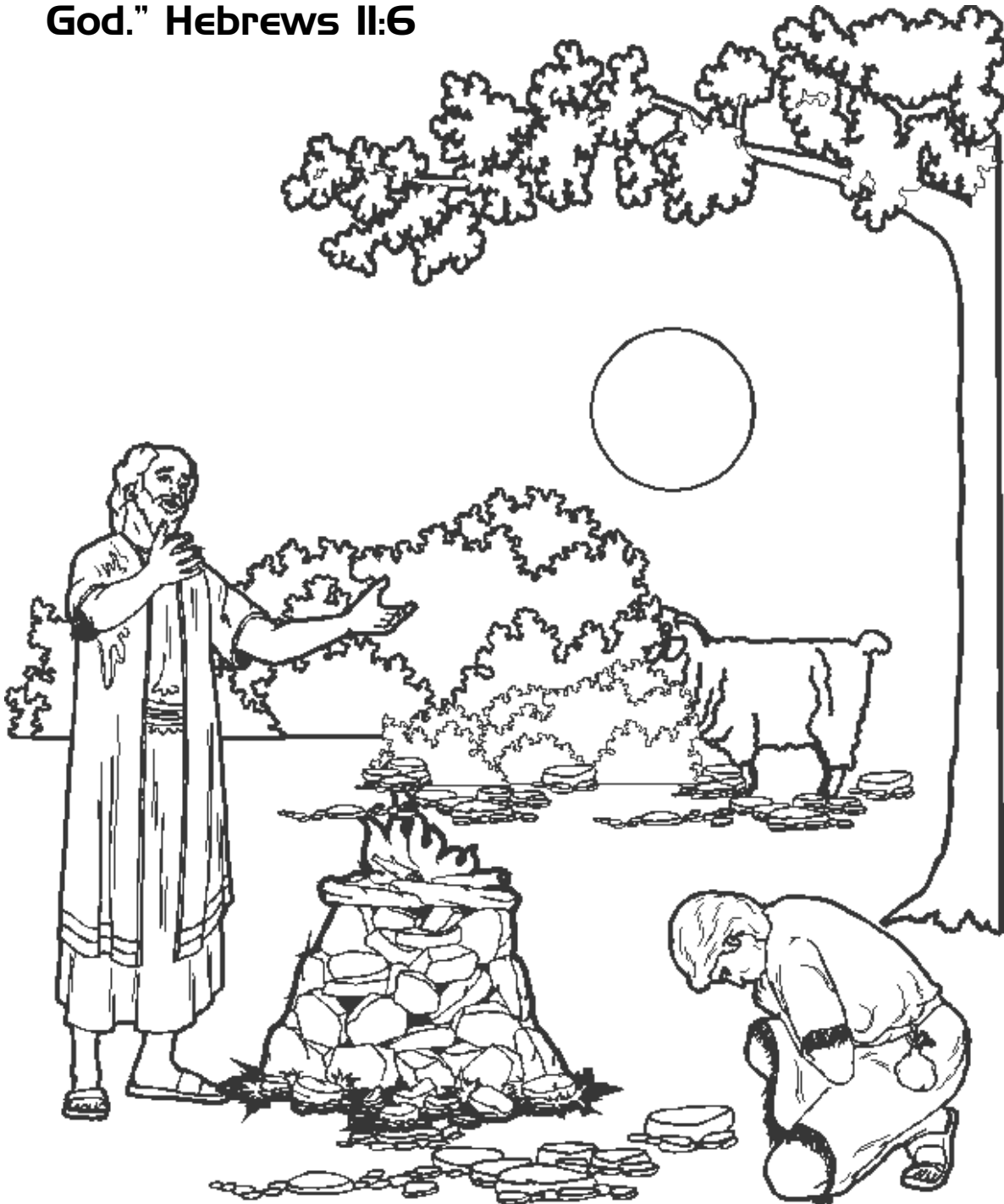


### A Parent's Blessing:
