Our Memory Verse this week:

"And they overcame him... by the word of their testimony." Revelation 12:11

Today we discovered:

- Testimonies reveal who God is.
- Testimonies remind us who we are in God
- The testimony of the Lord is the spirit of prophecy
- We get to be keepers of the testimony

Parent's Points to Ponder:

Your child learned from the previous lesson that the testimony of the Lord is a powerful tool for their Royal Mission. It is like a magnifying glass that sees and reveals God's heart and Kingdom. This lesson showed how important it is to receive and keep the testimonies which glorify Papa God and His Son, Jesus, and how the testimony brings His Kingdom to earth. Be encouraged to incorporate testimony and share time as a part of your child's daily life.

Ask Your Child:

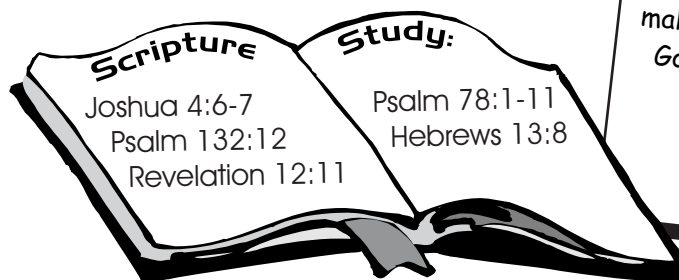
Why did the sons of Ephraim run away on the day of battle? (They forgot who they were, and how great God is). How should we "catch" or receive a testimony? (with faith). How can we be a keeper of the testimony? (share God stories" with others.)

Soaking Time:

In a soaking atmosphere, have your child invite the Holy Spirit to help them walk in God's power, anointing and presence. Let the Holy Spirit show your child how they can bring God's love and power to others. Encourage them to desire to be a testimony maker.

Home Activity:

Help your child to create a "Book of Remembrance". This can be as simple as a notebook with the cover decorated, or you can make your own with construction paper. Be creative and you can include a big feathery pen for writing. Record with your child all the great things God has done and the wonderful things He does for them everyday. Periodically, reread all the testimonies with all he family present.

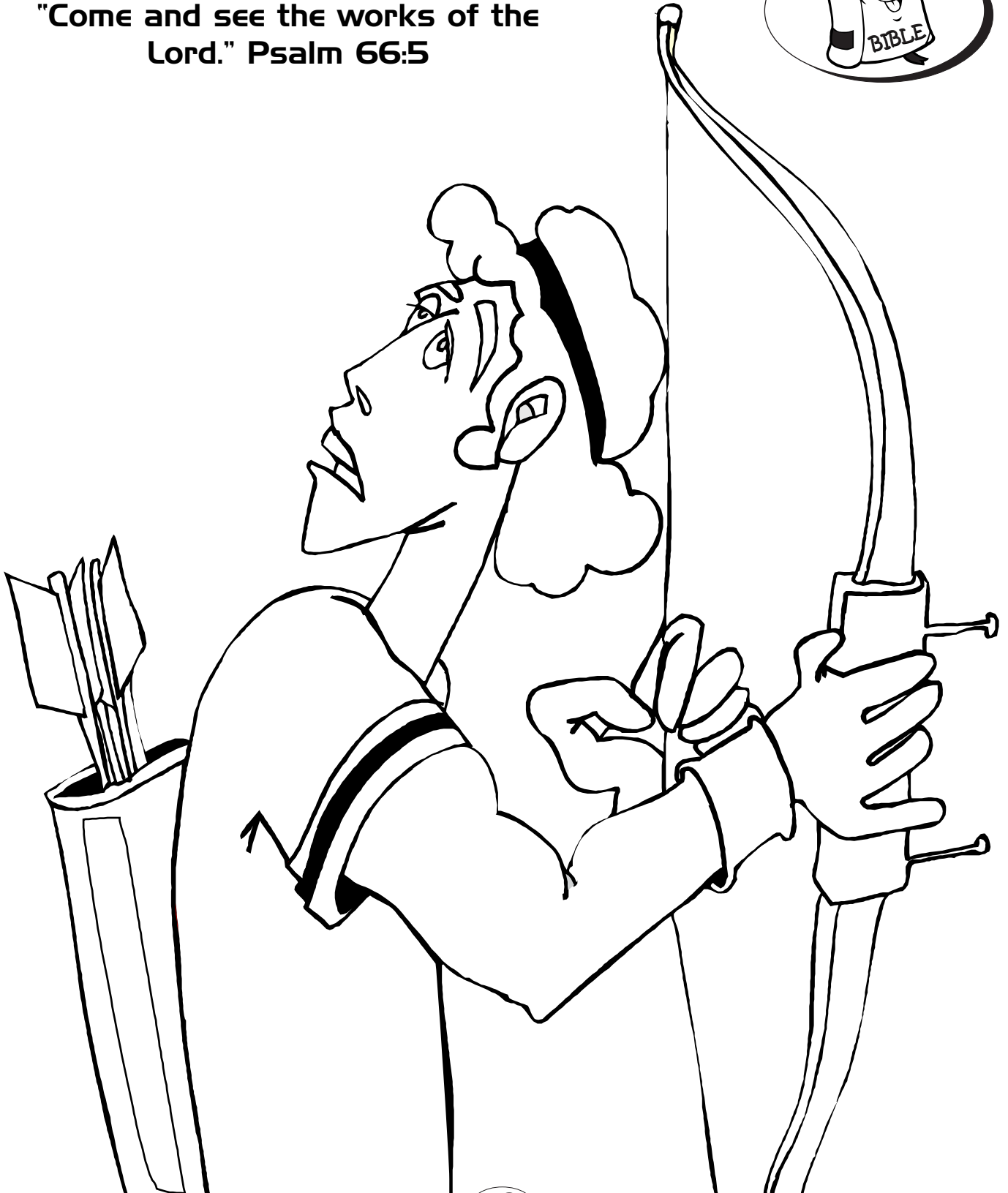
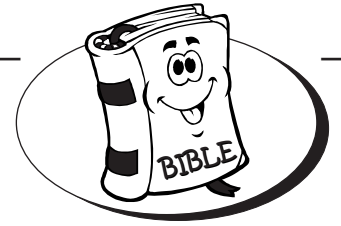
