Our Memory Verse this week:

"Your Word have I treasured in my heart..." Psalm 119:11

Today we discovered:

- God's Word is a precious, valuable treasure
- The Word of God feeds our spirit to make it strong

Parent's Points to Ponder:

In this lesson, your child got to go on a treasure hunt. They had the opportunity to discover how and why God's Word is such a precious, and valuable treasure. It is out of the Father's love that His Word was given to us. The Holy Spirit teaches that it is for reproof, correction and for training in righteousness, so that the children of God will be adequate and equipped for every good work... to complete their Royal Mission.

Ask Your Child:

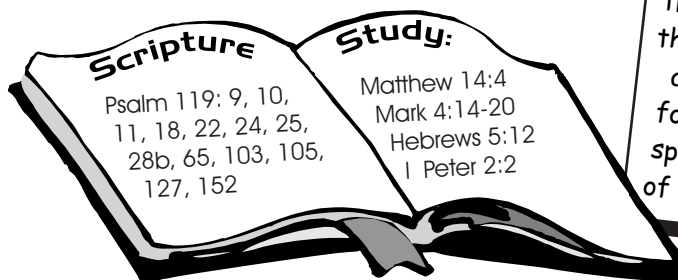
What was put into the Backpack? (It was gold/silver coins). How is God's Word like food? (It feeds and nourishes and strengthens our spirit) What kind of gifts does God's Word give us? (The gift of comfort, peace, purity and delight) How does God's Word help us on our journey? (It is like a map, and a compass to help us follow God, and it lights our path like a flashlight)

Soaking Time:

Have your child lay or sit down and begin to thank God for His precious treasure, His Word and all that it does for us. Ask the Holy Spirit to come and plant the Word into their hearts like a seed. Add your faith to the seed by believing it is true. Thank Papa for His Word by loving on Him. After awhile ask your child what happened during this time.

Home Activity:

Create a "treasure box" from God's Word.. you can use a shoe box or you can purchase an unfinished wooden box from a craft store. Have fun decorating the box together. Go on a treasure hunt and find things that show what God's Word is like (bread, seeds, compass, etc) Add to the box as you discover more of what is in God's Word.

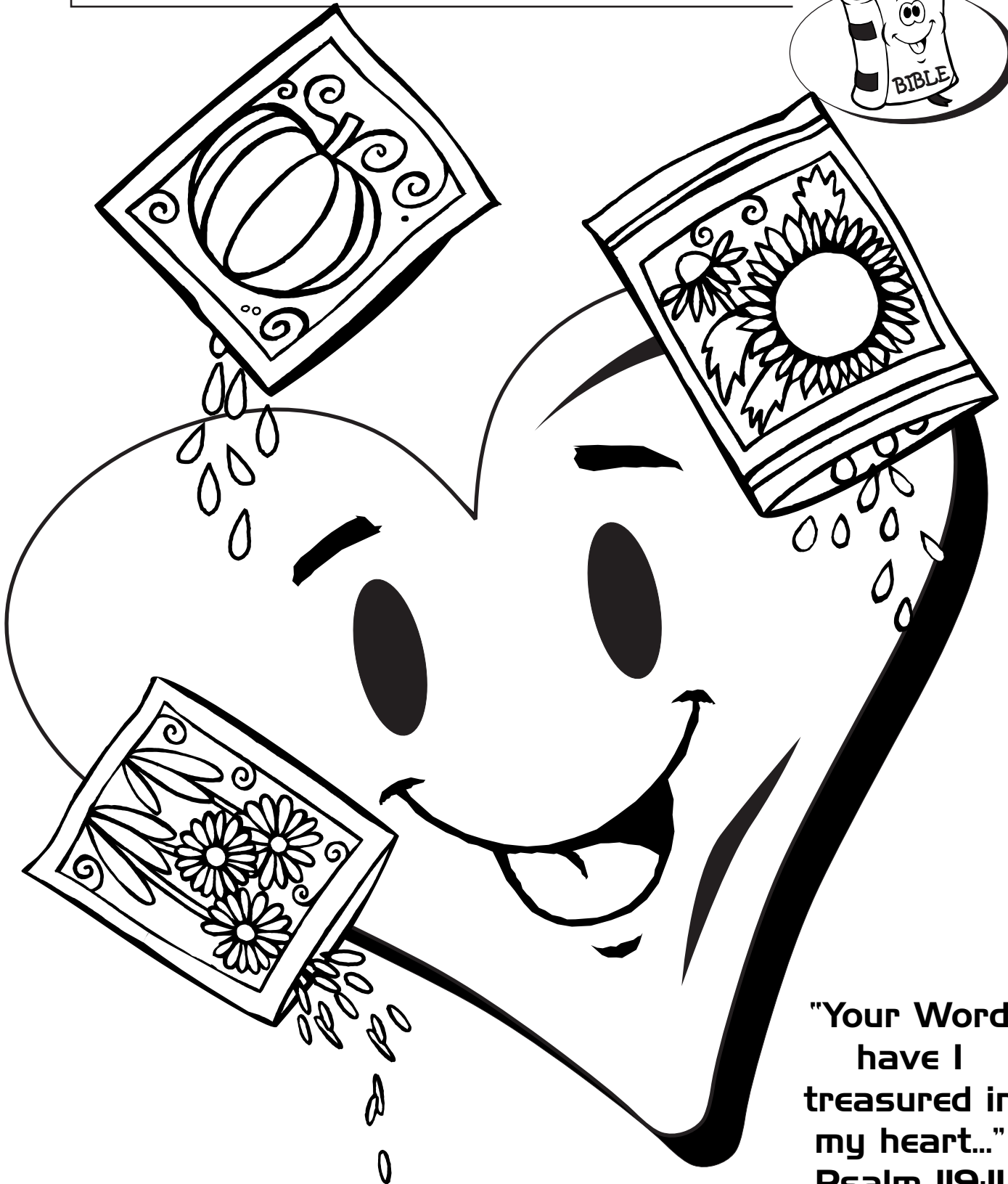
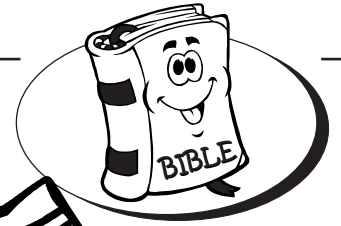

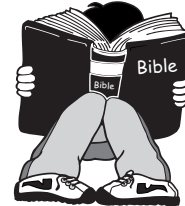
