Our Memory Verse this week:

Today we discovered:

Parent's Points to Ponder:

In this lesson, your child discovered from the story of a royal hero, David, that they too can strengthen themselves in the Lord. It happens when they choose to remember the words of promise, the testimony of the Lord, and by releasing praise. The result is a refreshed and recharged spirit, a defeated enemy, and a destiny pursued.

Ask Your Child:

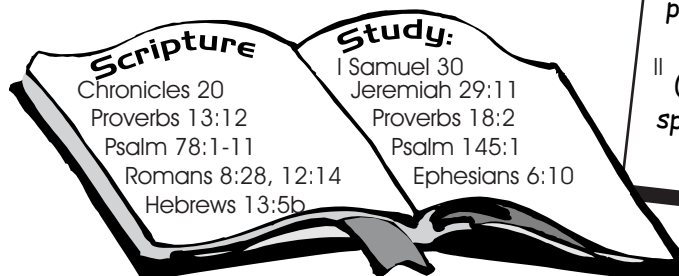
What was put into the Backpack? (a battery charger). How does the enemy deflate our "Destiny" balloon? (Disappointments, lies, rejection) Where can we strengthen ourselves? (In God's presence) How can we stay strong? (Having good friends and blessing others)

Soaking Time:

Have your child invite the presence of the Holy Spirit. Read Psalm 18:2. Ask the Holy Spirit to remind you of God's great promises from the Bible, and any prophetic or encouraging words you have received. Think about the great testimonies you have heard recently. After awhile, quietly praise God, telling Him how great and faithful He is. Ask you child how their heart feels.

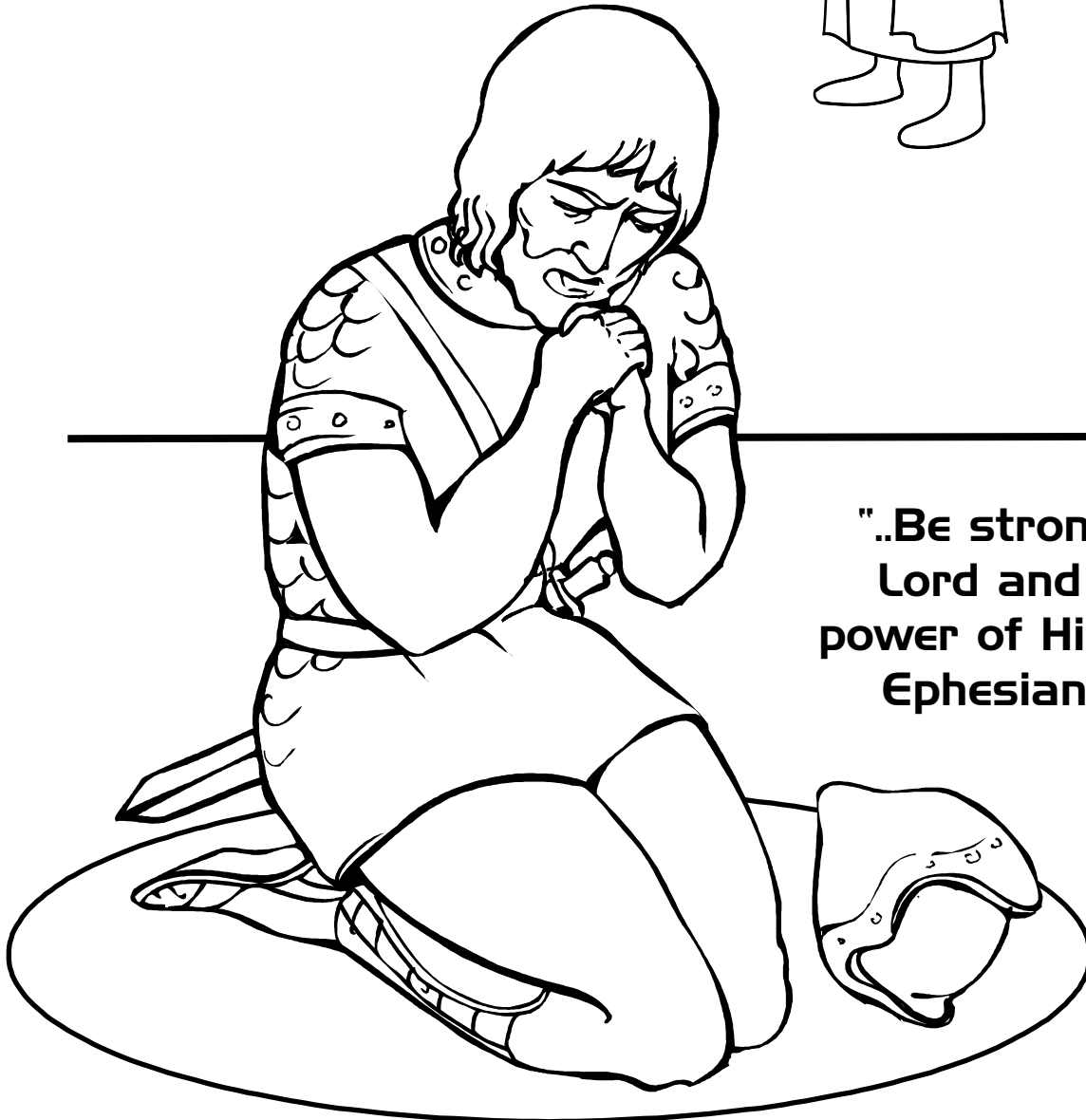
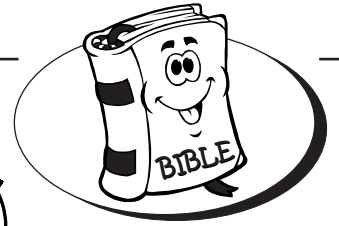
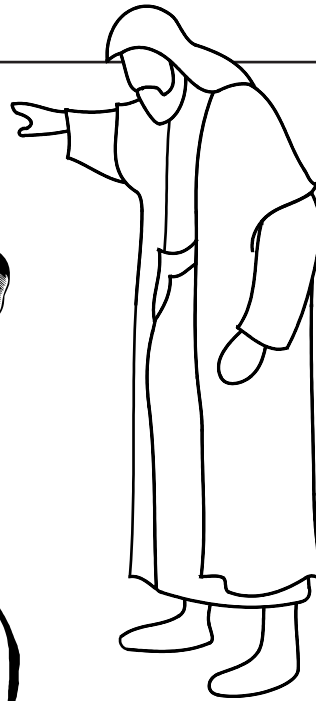
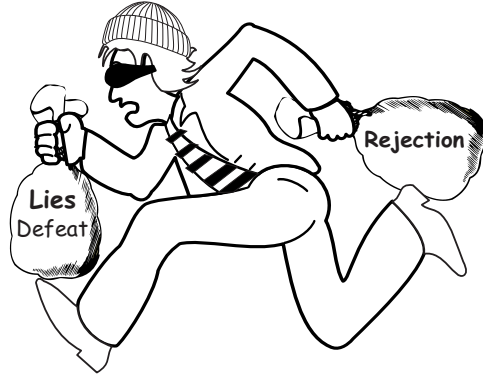
Home Activity:
