Our Memory Verse this week:

Today we discovered:

Parent's Points to Ponder:

Perhaps the most important thing for a child to know is what their Heavenly Father thinks of them. Although the depth of His love is unfathomable, it is so exciting to discover what God thinks about and sees when He is looking at His children. As these truths are received and believed within their hearts, the child's true identity is revealed. This leads to a transformed behavior and a pursuit of Godly destiny.

Ask Your Child:

What are some of God's thoughts about you?(We are valuable, His friends, His people) Are God's thoughts always good?(Yes) What is Papa God's greatest treasure? (His kids) What was put in the backpack? (Small bag of sand)

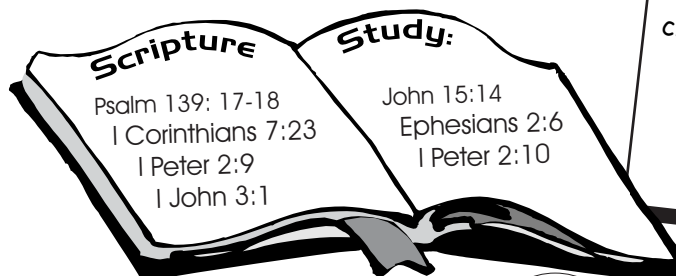
Soaking Time:

Let them know that their Heavenly Daddy thinks about them all the time. His thoughts are SO many...more than all the grains of sand in all the oceans and beaches on earth. His thoughts about them are precious because He loves them. With their eyes closed, begin to thank Papa God for all His thought about you:

- Let His thoughts begin to fall all over you like grains of sand
- Let Him show you and tell you each thought
- How does it feel to be so loved by your Father in Heaven?
- He thinks you are so valuable
- He thinks you are His friend
- He thinks you are so special
- What He thinks about you is true
- What He thinks about you is who you really are
- Thank Papa for each of His thoughts, and let Him know How much you love Him

Home Activity:

Following the "soaking time", help your child write down what God's thoughts are for them. Post it on the "Heaven's Window" bulletin board. You may also want to get a few different colors of sand and pour into a clear glass bottle as a reminder of how great His thoughts toward us are.

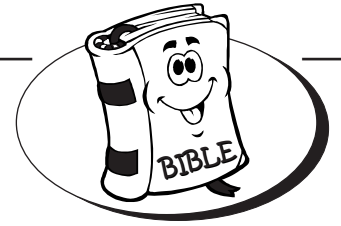

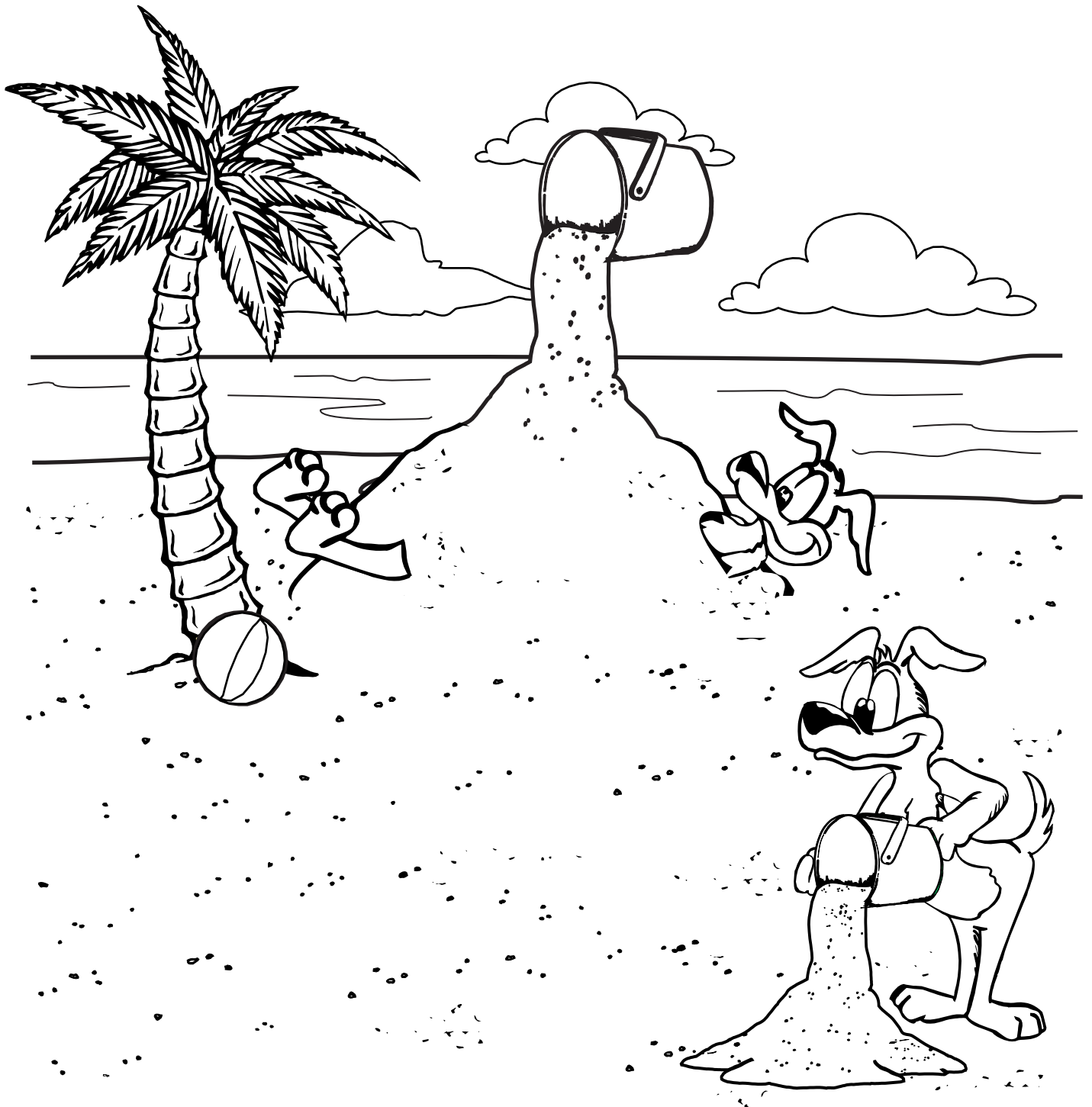
Parent's Blessing:
