

### Dear Parents:

Our Memory Verse this week:

"Give honor to whom honor is due" Romans 13:7

#### Today we discovered:

- Giving honor shows people God's heart for them
- When we honor those in authority, we are honoring God
- Honoring our parents and those in authority releases life and blessings
- Showing honor helps people see and receive God's Kingdom

#### Parent's Points to Ponder:

When our children live a life of giving honor, they are truly reflecting Heaven and the Father's heart. It will set them apart, and give them a place for godly influence. As a Kingdom principle, when honor is given, it brings us into agreement with God and a place to receive blessing and promise. Giving honor as a lifestyle also releases grace, which causes others to see God's Kingdom demonstrated and receive His love.

#### Ask Your Child:

How did Daniel treat the sinful king? (He honored and blessed him) What happens when we honor those in authority? (All receive from Heaven and get blessed) What are some ways we can honor parents? (Praying for them, obeying them, speaking to them in respectful ways, have a grateful heart) What was placed in the backpack? (A small trophy)

#### Soaking Time:

In a soaking atmosphere, lead the children to invite the Father's presence. Encourage them to thank Papa God for those in authority who minister for our good. Include: Father God, parents, teachers, soldiers, government, and police. Have your child pray prayers of honor and blessings.

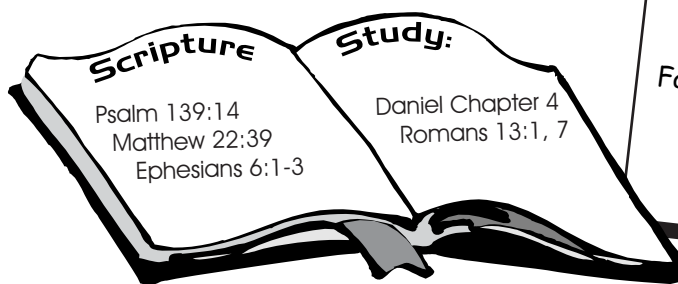
#### Home Activity:

A great way to honor those in authority is to send letters of blessings, prayers and encouragement. Have your child pray and ask the Father to show them who to "bless". Provide paper and art supplies for them to write or draw a picture of honor and thanks. Help them address the envelope and mail the letter if appropriate. You may also want to establish an "HONOR ROLL", by attaching a length of paper between two paper towel tubes. Write down the names of those in authority in their lives. Let this be a reminder to pray and bless them on a daily basis.
