Our Memory Verse this week:

"Be strong and courageous, do not fear..." Deuteronomy 31:6

Today we discovered:

Parent's Points to Ponder:

Your child learned that they can be a Kingdom hero and do brave things, like pray for the sick, give a prophetic word or share a testimony at school, the store or playground. They can do these things because they can be full of courage. Courage breaks through fear and the lies of the enemy, and helps them do the right thing, no matter what.

Ask Your Child:

What did all the Bible "Heroes" have in common? (Courage) Why was Jesus so courageous? (He was close to God and wanted to obey His Father) Can fear stop courage? (No) What was put in the backpack? (A badge of courage)

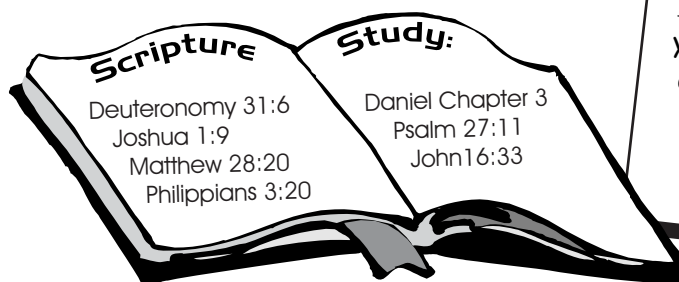
Soaking Time:

Jesus said to take courage, that He will be with us always and forever. Right now, let's enter the presence of the Father, receive courage and become a Kingdom hero.

- Climb on His lap and love on Him.
- Begin to thank Him for being good, kind and loving.
- Thank Him for being His child.
- Tell Him you want to please and obey Him.
- Ask Jesus to come and give you His badge of courage.
- Let Him know you want to be brave and courageous.
- Receive the badge/medal of courage and thank Him.
- Give Jesus a hug

Home Activity:

Remind your child that they are a son/daughter of Father God. They can trust Him, and Jesus is always with them. They do not have to fear or worry what others may think of them. Discuss with them during the week, what things they did or opportunities they had to be brave, and share God's love, power and Kingdom. What happened? Be sure to encourage this!

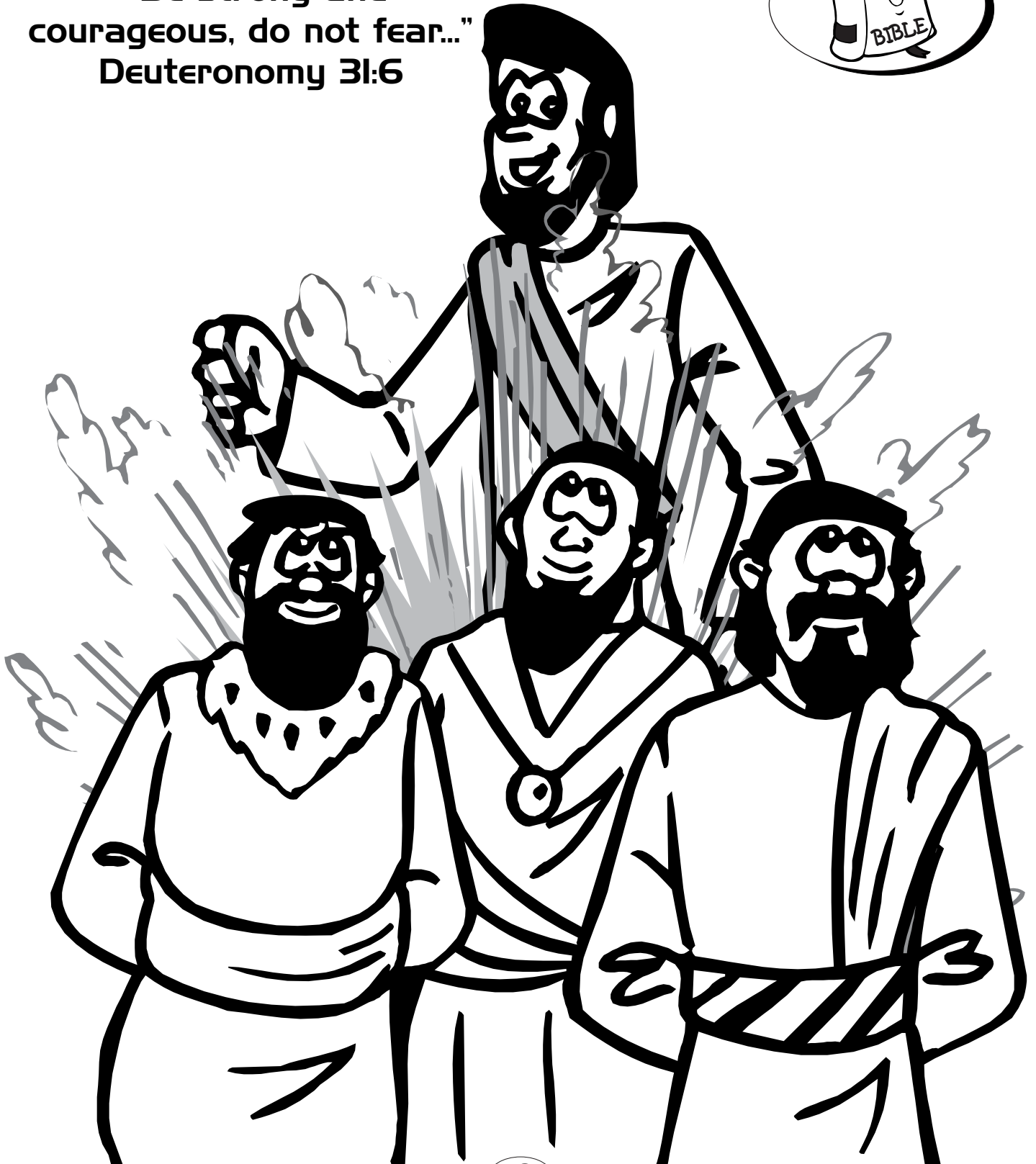

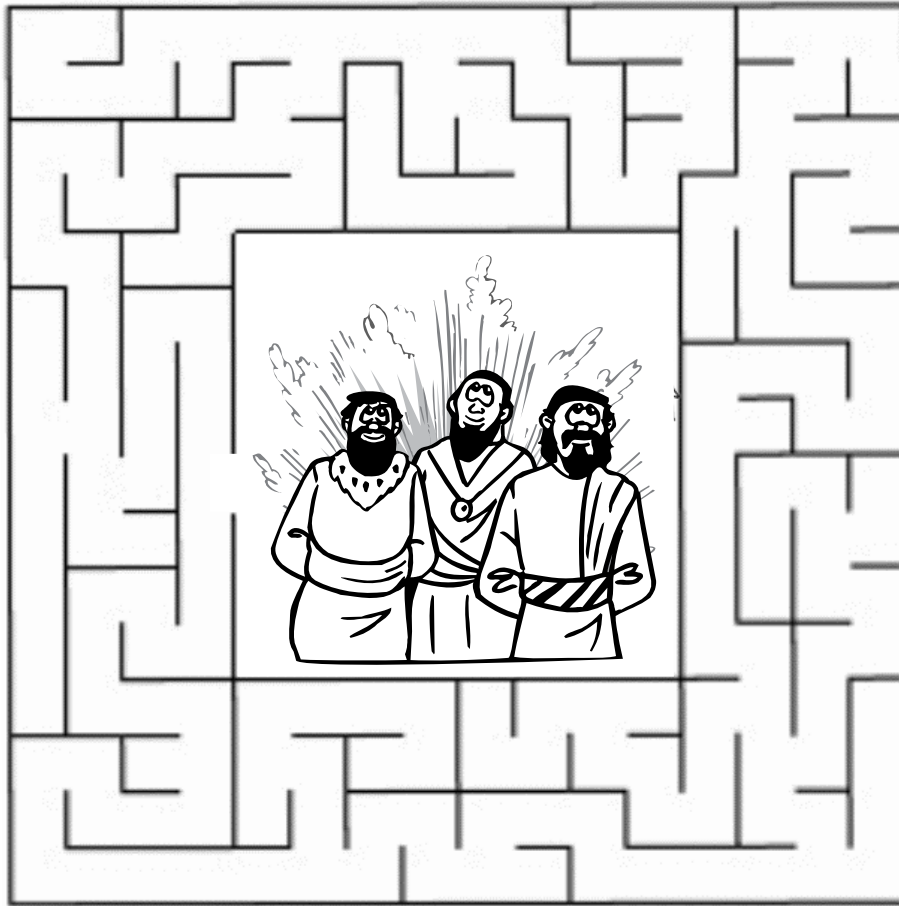
Parent's Blessing:
